

## Thanksgiving

Proverbs 3:5-6 5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

#### Philippians 4:6-7

Paul encouraged the Philippians to cultivate an attitude of prayer and gratitude to God. The result of such attitude is the experience of the unique peace that comes from God. It is one that surpasses all understanding, even the understanding that we so often lean unto. It is a kind of peace that mounts guard over our hearts and minds in Christ so that we focus only on the goodness of God. Where there is thanksgiving, God receives more and more glory.
