



## I WILL DWELL

Psalm 23:6 (NKJV)

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.

Where is the house of the Lord? Is it a physical place the believer dwells? Dwelling in the house of the Lord is more about an attitude than it is about being in a physical place. The presence of God is everywhere we are.
