1 – Walk In The Truth

3 John 1:1-5

1 The Elder, To the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth:
2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. **3** For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, just as you walk in the truth. **4** I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth. **5** Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do for the brethren and for strangers, **6** who have borne witness of your love before the church.

Paul invoked a prayer/blessing of prosperity in everything on Gaius after hearing of his walk in the truth. This walk had been observed by many who had met Gaius and they testified to Paul of such. Prosperity of the soul was the core of Paul's blessing. This linked physical prosperity and health to the spiritual well-being of the soul. This suggests that the believer's well-being comes from a prosperous inner life, which in turn touches the physical well-being. How do we walk in the truth like Gaius?

2 – All About Walking With Jesus

2 John 1:4-8

4 I rejoiced greatly that I have found some of your children walking in truth, as we received commandment from the Father. **5** And now I plead with you, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment to you, but that which we have had from the beginning: that we love one another. **6** This is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.

Walking in the truth is living a life that aligns with the desires of God and the teachings of Christ Jesus. At the core of this walk in the truth is loving one another and walking according to God's commandment to love Him with all our heart, mind, soul and strength and to love one another as He has loved us. This involves continually living in accordance with God's word and a commitment to being like Christ. May we continually pray for guidance and study God's word to know more about walking in the truth, for it has the power to make us prosperous in all things.
